A single person may keep:

\$ 15,450 in countable assets \$ 50 in monthly income Cemetery lot and marker Plus, exempt assets (a car, prepaid burial expenses, clothing, jewelry)

A married couple may keep (when one is in a nursing home):

\$ 126,420 maximum (\$74,820 or ½ of resources) \$ 3,160.50 a month in income for the community spouse One residence (with lien payable to Social Services) One car, personal property
